

## PRIVACY NOTICE CONCERNING

### THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA PROCESSED IN CONNECTION WITH CLAIMS AGAINST VOLT PRODUKCIÓ KFT.

In connection with the claims enforced against VOLT Produkció Kft. (hereinafter: “**Claim**”), VOLT Produkció Kft. necessarily processes personal data. Data processing occurs in accordance with Act CXII of 2011 on Informational Self-Determination and Freedom of Information, Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (hereinafter: “**GDPR**”), as well as Act V of 2013 on the Civil Code. In compliance with the requirements of the above referenced laws, we would like to inform you about the details of the processing of your personal data and your relevant rights.

<b>Personal data to be processed</b>	Personal data brought to the attention of the Controller in connection with the Claim.
<b>Purpose of processing</b>	Identification and investigation of the Claim, defense against the Claim, the exercise of the Controller’s rights during legal disputes and official procedures.
<b>Duration of processing</b>	The data processing lasts (i) for 15 (fifteen) days following the expiration of the deadline for submitting an extraordinary legal remedy after the final conclusion, or (ii) in case of submitting an extraordinary legal remedy, for 15 (fifteen) days after the final decision on the merits has been made.
<b>Legal basis for processing</b>	The legal basis for processing is the legitimate interest of the Controller (defense against the Claim) pursuant to GDPR Article 6 Paragraph 1 f).
<b>Transfer</b>	
Personal data are processed by the employees or agents of the Controller in order to achieve the abovementioned purposes. The Controller transfers the personal data related to the Claim to the relevant authority or court. No personal data will be transferred to third countries or to international organisations.	
<b>Rights, legal remedies, complaints</b>	
Pursuant to the GDPR, you may request access to the personal data and may request information about data processing (which will be provided by the Controller within no more than 1 month), may request rectification of personal data or their erasure (to the extent this is	

reasonably possible and there are no overriding legitimate grounds for the processing), or the restriction of data processing. You have the right to object.
